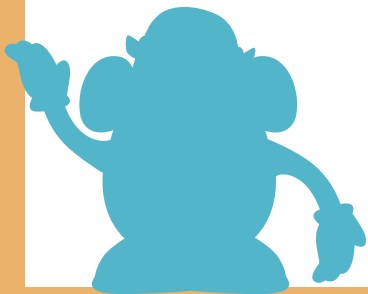


June 26th — June 30th

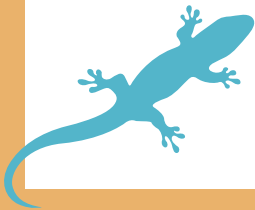

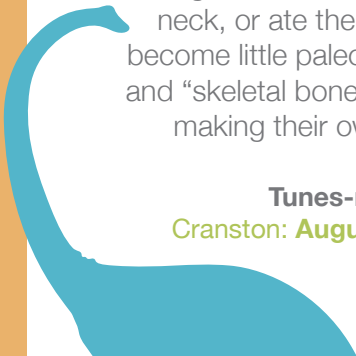
DINOSAUR WEEK
